- Students or parents should not offer any gifts to the teacher without the explicit permission of the principal.
- Ensure that your child comes to school neatly groomed and dressed in the prescribed school uniform.
- Make sure that your child is regular and punctual.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SCHOOL

1. Classes are from 9.00 am to 4.00 pm. Office hours are from 9.00 am to 5 pm.
2. Students are supposed to bring their school diary daily, which should be produced on demand by the principal or any teacher.
3. All students must attend the morning assembly. Late comers will be duly punished.
4. English is the only language permitted in the school campus for all interactions, formal and informal. This is applicable in the school buses also.
5. Proper and complete uniform is compulsory. A cheerful countenance, dignified dressing and behavior is always expected.
6. Personal hygiene is to be maintained.
Loose, torn or smelly socks must be avoided. New pairs are available in the school store.
7. Colouring of hair or using hair gel is not permitted.
8. Girls' hair should be plaited neatly on both sides and tied with ribbon / bush. Monthly hair cut and daily clean shave to be maintained by boys.
9. Nails should be trimmed weekly. Girls and Boys are not allowed to grow their nails. Nail polish is strictly prohibited. No colourful ribbons, bands or bushes are permitted on Wednesdays except the respective house colours.
10. Uniform is not for style or show. It symbolizes unity and uniformity, not diversity. It also indicates equality and sense of belonging to the institution.

11. Greeting the authority and teachers with respect and courtesy is a must. Such courtesy should be extended to other students as well.
12. Running, Playing or shouting in classrooms and in corridors are strictly prohibited. During school hours students should move about with their hands at the back.
13. Move in line with hands at the back in perfect silence to attend the classes outside the classroom.
14. During interval student are not supposed to play inside the class.
15. Students are forbidden from bringing packed food items, mobile phone, i-pad, pen drives and C.D. to the school. Strict action will be taken if such cases are found.
16. Irregular attendance, habitual negligence in school work, dishonesty, obscenity in word or act, serious misconduct or threats even outsidess school are sufficient reason for dismissal.
17. Pupils must not do any damage to school property. Those who cause the damage will be liable to repair it at their ow cost.
18. Keep classrooms and school premises clean. The waste paper basket should be used for this purpose. Tearing pages from note books for making paper– arrows is not allowed.
19. Promotion is granted on the basis of the general progress of the pupil during the academic year.
20. Students who are sick and are granted medical leave for genuine reasons during the examination may be considered for the promotion if their progress has been satisfactory through the academic year.
21. Regular attendance is expected of every student. No student shall absent himself/herself from class without the prior permission of the class teacher or principal. If prior permission cannot be attained for reasons beyond control, a leave application signed by the parent or guardian should be sent to the principal.

22. Students taking leave for 15 consecutive days or more without intimation will have their names removed from the rolls, they may be charged a fee of Rs. 500 for readmission.
23. A student who fails twice consecutively in the same class will not be permitted to continue his/her studies in the school.
24. The principal can amend any rules or introduce new rules without notice and such rules will be binding on all students parents and teachers.
25. Hands and Legs should be kept under control No "Odd or Even Games" should be played during class hours or in the school vehicles.
26. During the National Anthem students should stand in attention. No-one should be running in the play-ground / auditorium or along the corridors during National Anthem.

THE SCHOOL BUS

1. Only students up to class VII will be allowed to travel by school bus.
2. Refined behavior is expected in the school bus. Any misbehavior of will be seriously dealt with.
3. Students are allowed to board buses other than their own.
4. They must produce the bus pass for inspection daily.
5. Bus fare must be paid strictly every month, failing which a fine will be charged.
6. English Speaking is compulsory in the bus.
7. As good citizens of the country, all should obey the traffic rules.
8. Bus pass is issued normally for a full academic year. In case of termination during the academic year, a month's fare will be charged as fine.

LIBRARY RULES

There are two courses for the external examinations, one at the secondary level, towards the ten year terminal examination known as the Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (ICSE) examination and the other at the higher secondary level leading to the Plus two examination, namely the Indian School Certificate (ISC) examination. Both the certificates are recognized by all the universities in India. Malayalam is taught from UKG and Hindi from std. I.

THE SCHEME OF THE I.C.S.E. EXAMINATION

The ICSE Examination is held in March every year for the Students of Std. X.

ADMISSION, PROMOTION, WITHDRAWAL

1. No child less than the minimum age required as per K.E.R. or more than seven years old by the beginning of the school year will be admitted to the First standard..
2. Promotions are granted on the basis of the whole year's work of the pupil. Records of homework, monthly tests, mid term tests etc. will be taken into account along with the performance in the annual examination.
3. Before the withdrawal of a student, one month's notice in writing must be given, failing which an additional month's fees will be charged.
4. A student who fails in several subjects or is refused promotion twice in the same standard must leave the school.

FEES

The School is purely a self – supporting institution. It does not receive any financial aid or grant from any agency. Tuition fee would be charged for 12 months of the year. The management solicits the whole hearted co-operation of parents for the prompt and systematic payment of fees so that the school functions smoothly. The special fee is collected in three installments – June, September and January and tuition fees, in monthly installments. There will be no other fee collection, for example examination fee, annual day fee etc. during the year. Payment of both special fees and monthly fees are to be made on or before the month. **Monthly fees should be paid before 10th of every month. Defaulters should pay a fine of Rs. 10 from the 10th to 20th, Rs. 20 from 20th to 30th and should pay Rs. 50/- after the month. Defaulters will not be given attendance . This may lead to the removal of the student from the roll for continuous absence as per rules and he/she will not be readmitted without the special permission of the Principal, paying a readmission fee of Rs. 500/-.** Parents are encouraged to remit the whole year's fees together in the beginning of the academic year itself.
